Dear Cr Johnston

At its meeting held on 6 August 2019, Council considered a petition from residents requesting the route 196 BUZ service be extended to Yeronga. The petition recommended that Council would write to TransLink and ask that they consider the petitioners request.

TransLink has now responded and advised the extension of the route 196 BUZ route would result in the bus service duplicating the rail service that operates between Yeronga Station and Fairfield Station with this corridor currently being serviced by high frequency rail services.

Furthermore, they advised a review of existing bus services that operate in and around Yeronga indicate service levels align with the current levels of demand and an extension of the route 196 is not being considered at this time.

I trust this information is of assistance.
