### Construction starts at Honour Avenue centre

Brisbane City Council is working with the local community to breathe life back into the shopping centre strip along Honour Avenue between Mortlake Road and Wylie Street, through the Honour Avenue Graceville Suburban Centre Improvement Project (SCIP).

Council is spending \$3.75 million on streetscape improvements for this important community hub, which includes a \$375,000 contribution from property owners in the shopping strip.

Since 1996, Council has invested more than \$41 million in 46 suburban centres across Brisbane such as Kenmore, Cannon Hill and St Lucia. Improvements at the Honour Avenue centre will include new street trees, garden beds, seating, artwork and footpath upgrades that will make the area more attractive and increase foot traffic for local businesses.

Over the past year, Council has worked with the Honour Avenue Graceville SCIP Community Reference Group (comprising property owners, community groups and residents) to develop the SCIP.

During construction Council will minimise disruption to businesses and residents within the precinct and access to all shops will be maintained during trading hours. Night works will be required and nearby properties may experience some construction noise, low levels of vibration and increased lighting.

The official opening of the new SCIP will be in in mid-2016. We thank you for your support of this exciting project for Graceville.
