Thank you for your email of 28 November 2023 regarding Cactoblastis Corner in Sherwood.

Following the 2021-22 floods, extraordinary funding was made available to rehabilitate community and recreational assets under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

I can confirm that in early 2023, Brisbane City Council (Council) made a submission to the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA) for extraordinary funding to repair landslips at Cactoblastis Corner sustained during the South East Queensland Rainfall and Flooding event of 22 February - 5 April 2022.

In April 2023, Council was advised that its submission for restoration work at Cactoblastis Corner had been assessed and approved. I understand the project is currently in the investigation and planning phase, with rehabilitation works planned to be completed in 2024.

Thank you again for your email. I trust that this information has been useful to you and allayed your concerns about this project.
